Adriano Stellino, 22 years old, student of the Istituto d'Arte Applicata e Design – Torino (IAAD) was ranked first in the international car competition "Stile Italiano Giovani".

The competition, born in 1998 on the initiative of the ANFIA Car Coachbuilders Group and reached its sixth year, represents an interesting opportunity for young talents to express their creativity and skills of interpretation.

The participants have developed solutions to internal and / or external cars of all types, choosing a brand, a model and a name without any constraint of representation or a specific theme to follow.

Among the over one hundred projects coming from young designers' inspiration from 27 different nationalities, the "Porsche 917" by Adriano Stellino was considered by the jury "a stylistic and technical complete project, with consistent proportions of the car body in different views".

The best twenty projects will be exhibited until November 23 at Torino Esposizioni, inside "Dream", the third meeting of the "Automobile Trilogy".

The IAAD, in celebrating 30 years of teaching, is pleased to celebrate the prestigious prize given to a student of 3rd year of the Bachelor in Transportation design.
