CALL FOR ALLOCATION OF MOBILITY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. Purpose

IAAD, as partner in the "International Routes: Arts Creating Future - IRACF" project - CUP E16E24000020006 – funded by Next Generation EU (NGEU) – for the internationalisation of Higher Education in Art and Music (Istituti di Istruzione Superiore Artistica e Musicale, AFAM) according to the National Plan for Recovery and Resilience (Piano Nazionale di Ripresa e Resilienza, PNRR) MISSION 4 COMPONENT 1 - INVESTMENT 3.4 SUB-INVESTMENT T5, intends to promote international mobility programmes to encourage educational, cultural and personal exchange of international students through a study experience in its own campus in Italy.

The experience intends to enhance one's academic curriculum, strengthen technical and creative skills and promote internationalisation in education.

IAAD. offers, for the participation in **IAAD. Mobility Design Workshop** happening **from 15 to 27 September 2025** in its campus in Via Pisa 5/D, 10152, Torino (TO):

- n. 4 scholarships for students or graduates within 12 months coming from outside of the EU worth 2000€ each.

2. Addressees

The call is addressed to international students regularly enrolled at least in the 3^o or 4^o year in their bachelor or single-cycle degree programmes or ex-students who graduated within the last 12 months in: Product Design, Industrial Design, Transportation design, Engineering.

During the selection process, the promoting body ensures that the principles of equal opportunities, non-discrimination and inclusion are respected, in line with the Charter of Fundamental Rights of the European Union.

3. Activities

During the mobility period, students will participate to the IAAD. Mobility Design Workshop in object as scheduled.

Applying to the present call is an automatic application to the above-mentioned activity (Annex I).

4. Terms and timing of the grant

Selected students will receive a financial contribution to help them with travel, board and lodging expenses. The contribution's amount may vary according to the students' country of origin, according to the parameters set by the project in point 1.

Payment of the mobility grant contribution may only be made by crediting a bank or postal account in the name of the beneficiary.

Payment of the mobility grant contribution will be made in two instalments:

- Down payment – 50% of the total will be disbursed within 3 days of the beginning of the workshop;
- Balance – the remaining 50% will be disbursed following the successful participation in the Mobility Design Workshop and after the submission of a final report.

Should the participant, after signing of the agreement with IAAD., find themselves unable to take part or forced to interrupt the mobility activity, the financial contribution given to cover the above-mentioned expenses shall be reimbursed in full to IAAD by the participant.

Eligibility for financial support under this call is incompatible with other EU grants from other EU-funded programmes or actions.

5. Admission requirements

To participate in selection procedure of this call, students must meet and demonstrate the following requirements:

- Have attended at least two years of study in a bachelor or single-study degree in Design or Engineering (point 2);
- Being regularly enrolled for the A.Y. 25/26 at least in the 3° or 4° year in their bachelor or single-cycle degree programmes in Product Design, Industrial



Design, Transportation design, Engineering (point 2) or having graduated in same major within the last 12 months;

- Possess a level of English corresponding to at least level B1.

6. Terms and modalities for applications

Interested students must present their application online through the following Google form ([LINK](#)) by and not later than **23 July 2025**, 12:00 Central Time Zone, attaching:

- A copy of valid passport;
- Curriculum Vitae with one's studies and possible work experience;
- Updated art portfolio;
- A small video presentation (60") or motivational letter (1800 characters max, spaces included);
- Self-certification, or official certificate, of English level (at least B1).

IAAD reserves the faculty to request integrations to the documents submitted.

Applications that don't meet the requirements listed in point 5, that are incomplete and/or without requested documents, that arrive after the indicated deadline or through a different channel than indicated won't be considered.

7. Selection process and ranking list

The selection will be carried out by an internal Commission that will assign a score from 1 to 15 points based on the following criteria:

- Portfolio artistic quality - from 1 to 5 points;
- Previous experiences, if any, in the Mobility/Transportation field (e.g. contests, courses, exercises) – from 1 to 3 points;
- Personal motivation and coherence with the educational experience – from 1 to 5 points;
- Language knowledge – 1 point in the case of B1, 2 points in the case of B2 or higher levels certified by official certification.

ATTENTION: in the event of a tie, the ranking will be based on the time of application.

The ranking list from this selection process will be published on the IAAD website by 25 July 2025 and all applicants will be informed through an official email.

It will be necessary for all selected students to confirm the acceptance of the grant within 5 days from the communication of the ranking's publishing.

8. Recognition of educational activities

At the end of the mobility period IAAD will provide each student with a participation certificate to present to their own institutions for recognition.

9. Obligations of selected students

Selected students undertake to:

- Sign a specific agreement with IAAD;
- Regularly attend the activities planned at IAAD;
- Draw up a final report on the experience.

10. Personal data protection statement

The personal information of which IAAD will become aware during the application and selection process will be processed in accordance with EU Regulation 2016/679 - GDPR ('GDPR').
